28" and over - \$55

Plasma TVs under 21" - \$20; 21" and over \$30.

**FLUORESCENT LAMPS:** first 5 free per household additional for Andover residents - 50¢-4'; 75¢- 8'; more for other size

**MATTRESSES & BOX SPRINGS:** Dry and not moldy. \$15 each

**TIRES:** Price depends on size

**MATERIALS THAT ARE FREE**

**BATTERIES:** Lead acid car, boat and motorcycle rechargeable batteries - The Knights of Columbus collects these batteries

**BICYCLES:** Any condition. They are repaired and given away

**BOOKS, CD's, DVD's** - put into drop box

**DOCUMENT SHREDDING** (in front of Public Works garage)

**PROPANE TANKS**

**SCRAP METAL:** All metals, must be free from other materials

**USEABLE HOUSEHOLD ITEMS:** \*\*\* No junk or items in need of repair
